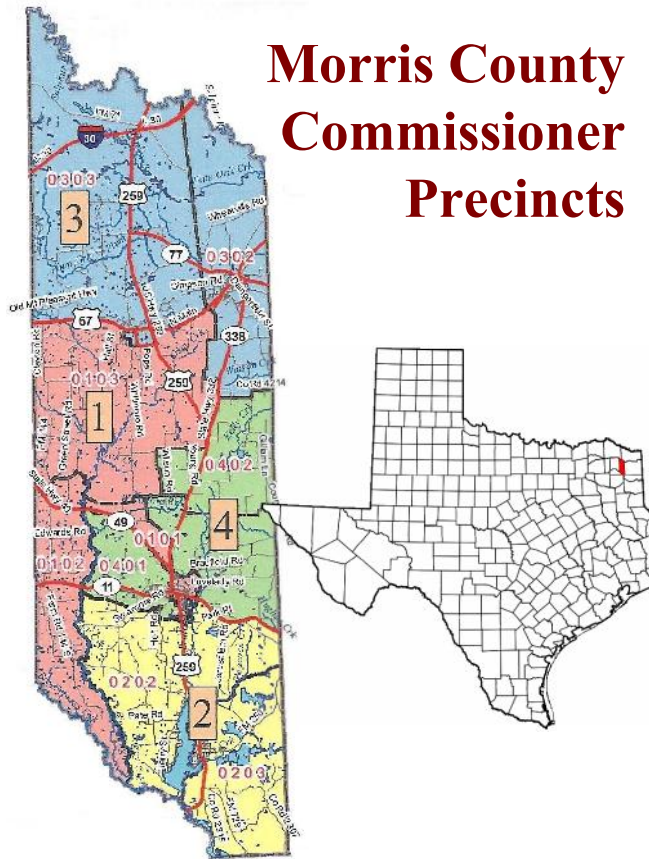

Morris County's Top Ten List

Morris County provides many programs and services. The county initiates some services, and others are programs run in cooperation with the state and federal government.

1 • Commissioners Court

Morris County's governing body – four County Commissioners and the County Judge

2 • Public Safety

Sheriff's Department oversees the jail and patrols the unincorporated county

3 • Courts

Criminal, civil, and probate courts; jury services; Justices of the Peace

4 • District Attorney

Oversees criminal prosecution, represents Child Protective Services, represents all Morris County elected officials

5 • County Treasurer

Receipt all county revenues, pays vendors, process payroll

6 • Roads and Transportation

Maintain county roads, contracts with cities to repair and service roads, buys right of way

7 • Tax Assessor/Collector

Vehicle transactions, voter registrar

8 • County Clerk

Recorder of real property, registrar of birth and death records, issues marriage licenses, clerk of county and commissioner's courts, administers all county and state elections

9 • District Clerk

Maintains official court records and receives for filing all felony, criminal, family, juvenile, delinquent tax, and other civil cases

10 • AgriLife

Agriculture Extension Services: agriculture and consumer science information
