COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER  
EXTENDING DISASTER DECLARATION DUE TO DAMAGES RESULTING FROM  
TORNADIC ACTICVITY

WHEREAS, ON NOVEMBER 7, 2022, THE COUNTY JUDGE ISSUED A PROCLAMATION DECLARING A STATE OF DISASTER FOR MORRIS COUNTY RESULTING FROM THE SUFFERED WIDESPREAD OR SEVERE DAMAGE, INJURY, OR LOSS OF LIFE OR PROPERTY RESULTING FROM TORNADIC ACTIVITY; AND


WHEREAS, THE CONDITIONS NECESSITATING DECLARATION OF A STATE OF DISASTER CONTINUE TO EXIST; AND


WHEREAS, §418.108(B) OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE PROVIDES THAT A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER MAY NOT BE CONTINUED FOR A PERIOD IN EXCESS OF SEVEN DAYS WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MORRIS COUNTY:

1. THAT THE STATE OF DISASTER PROCLAIMED FOR THE COUNTY OF MORRIS BY THE COUNTY JUDGE ON NOVEMBER 7, 2022, SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL TERMINATED BY ORDER OF THE COUNTY JUDGE.
2. THIS ORDER IS PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE AND PURSUANT TO §418.108 ET SEQ. AND THE MORRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN AND SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE 14TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 2022.
3. THIS ORDER SHALL BE GIVEN PROMPT AND GENERAL PUBLICITY AND PROMPTLY FILED WITH THE COUNTY CLERK.


