## AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX RATE FOR THE COUNTY OF MORRIS FOR THE TAX YEAR 2017



BE IT ORDAINED AND ORDERED by the Commissioner's Court of Morris County that:

We, the Commissioner's of Morris County do hereby levy or adopt the rate on each \$100.00 worth of property located within the County of Morris, made taxable by law, for the tax year 2017 as follows:

Road & Bridge Fund	.089496
Interest & Sinking Fund	.009888
TOTAL TAX RATE	.491449

WHEREAS, these funds are necessary and appropriate for the funding of the 2017-2018 Morris County budget, and

WHEREAS, said budget has been heretofore regularly adopted by the Commissioner's of Morris County, and

WHEREAS, all other things required by law to be done have been done properly by the appropriate officials.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by affirmative vote of the Commissioner's of Morris County, Texas, at a regular meeting held in the Commissioner's Courtroom of the Morris County Courthouse in Daingerfield, TX on the 11 day of September, 2017.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 4.24 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$38.67.
